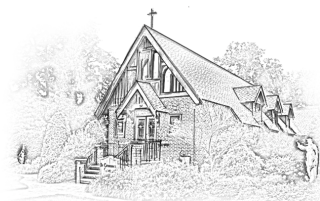

Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

You changed my mourning into dancing;
O LORD, my God, forever will I
give you thanks.

— Psalm 30:12, 13



Dear Parishioners,

After all the Solemnities and Big Feasts, this Sunday we are celebrating the 10th Sunday in Ordinary Time. And we are invited to focus that Jesus came so that we may have life and have it full.

Recalling the spectacular events that happened in this Sunday's Gospel, we see God's power at work in the raising to life the son of a widow in Nain. St. Luke describes the events with great simplicity and few words. Jesus enters the city, and encounters a funeral cortege. Presumably it is like any other funeral procession; mourners carrying the deceased followed by family members. It is a familiar scene; yet it is somewhat different too, because here the main mourner is a widowed mother and the deceased is her only son.

In order to better understand the importance of these details and a reason why Jesus ultimately does what he does, we need to remember that under Jewish Law, special care of widows was always taken because in a world before welfare and life insurance, a widow was often left to rely on the generosity and charity of others. This was especially true of a widow without children to take care of her. Here, this widow is now all alone and vulnerable.

This is the reality of the situation that moves Jesus to pity and causes him to intervene in a such a miraculous and spectacular manner. In doing so, Jesus shows his very heart and the depth of his compassion to all who grieve and are in need. In the midst of great sadness and pain, He turns the very law of nature upside down; one who is dead is restored to life and restored and eventually to the community. Hence it is no surprise that the response of the people is one of great rejoicing, mixed with even greater fear. How else would one equally imagine the questions that were voiced: Who is this Jesus? By what power did he do that?

Perhaps as we have heard all of these readings proclaimed today, we might have reflected on how we need that gentle, life-changing touch of Jesus in our lives. Where do Christ's great compassion and concern need to touch our lives and to bring its healing to our sometimes or most of the time tired and weary spirits? What part of our lives need to be revived? The compassion that Jesus has shown in today's Gospel is the same compassion that he extends to each one of us every day. He is the Emmanuel, God-with-us, with his people, offering us in his eternal life.

May God bless us all.

Parish Policies

Parish Registration ... To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email frontoffice@sienachurch.org.

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

Young adults ...who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, **should register with the Parish under their own name.**

Weddings ... Please call the Parish Office **one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).**

Baptisms ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

Sponsorship ... In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... **also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months.** One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
