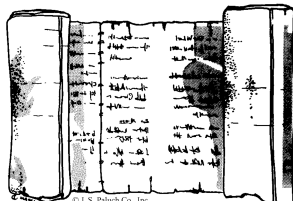

Dear Parishioners,

Last week, the Clergy of the Diocese of Trenton had a meaningful and fruitful Annual Convocation. It was an excellent time to be together for prayers, relaxation, brotherhood, camaraderie and get together. The theme of the annual convocation was, "The Spirituality of Stewardship". There were three guest speakers, two priests and a lay person. The talks were so enriching, experiential and enlightening. I cannot share all of the pastoral and practical inputs, however, I fully remember from the talk that in the parish community the term "volunteer" should not be used but instead use the word "steward" or "disciple" which makes sense for when we receive baptism we committed ourselves to Christ and His Church. We are all created by God together with our God-given gifts, talents, potentials, and treasures. Hence, we should be returning them to the Lord as a sign of our gratitude. We should have the sense of responsibility to our parish in many ways for we should be thinking of ourselves as part of a parish family. For family members, we share a common heritage and history. We as a family of God should be grounded in the same beliefs, values and traditions. We should embrace new members of the family with the spirit of love and acceptance. Some insights on stewardship also is to use our gifts and talents for the good and benefit of the parish as we have mentioned before. Please always remember that God has given each of us the gift of time. How do we make use of them? How many hours do we spend in front of our TV's, computers and telephones, etc.? Time is precious. Time is gold. Make use of them wisely. Here are some suggestions: Be a steward in our Mass Ministry. Are you comfortable in public speaking, then you might get involved as a reader. If you are friendly and outgoing, be an usher. You can share your deep devotion to the Holy Eucharist by becoming an Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist of Holy Communion. If you play an instrument or sing, the music ministry might be the right place for you. Maybe you are a parent, a teacher and could help in our religious education program. You could be an aide or traffic supervisor in the parking lot, or help in the office whenever there are religious education classes in the parish community. Any expertise? Currently, the parish is in dire need of somebody who can lead the Altar Rosary Society. Somebody who is interested to lead the Respect Life Ministry to represent the parish in the Diocese, please don't hesitate to come forward and step up to the plate.

Finally, some say Jesus never talked about money and possessions. In the Gospel this Sunday, it is a fact that Jesus talked about it in parables, in direct teachings, and in the example of his life. Jesus called his disciples to understand that nothing is their own no matter how much they earned, how hard they worked, and whose name is listed as owner. For the children of the light, everything belongs to God. We are but God's stewards of what God has given us. We are to use everything that we have to serve God. That being said, we are called to serve our parish financially. You know how costly it is to run your own home. The parish faces even higher costs and depends on parishioners to help meet the needs. Why don't we take a look at the money you put in your envelope each week. Do you increase your contributions each year as the cost of living rises? Giving to the Church is more than just a financial obligation. Once we recognize that everything that you have is a gift from God, you see that giving generously to continue God's work in our parish is an essential part of your spirituality. God of goodness and justice, we believe that you are our true wealth and you have entrusted us with the goods of all creation. May we use them wisely and work to see that all have a fair share in them. Make us your generous stewards, modeled after the image of your beloved Son. Amen. Father Angelito

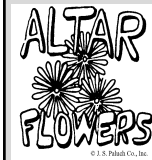

Baptisms ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

Sponsorship ... In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... **also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months.** One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
