Dear Parishioners,

Today is EASTER SUNDAY of the Resurrection of the Lord. A Happy and Blessed Easter to everyone!

A lot of people in this present time and age with the advancement of science, technology and almost everything are wondering about the origins of Christianity. All we can say is that there have been recent studies and they indicate that from the earliest days of a Christian community its members were making bold claims concerning the identity of Jesus, claiming for a role in salvation that could only be true of God. Nonetheless, an earlier generation of scholars had tended to think that the identification of Jesus with God was something that developed only from Christianity, but this seems to not be the case. From the outset, Christians affirm the divine status of Jesus.

Now this raises the inquiry of what possibly could have led the first generation of Christians, almost all of whom were Jewish, to identify Jesus of Nazareth with the God who made a covenant with Abraham and his descendants, who freed the Israelites from captivity in Egypt, and who promised through the prophets to bless all the families of nations. Certainly, the answer in the Book of the new Testament is unambiguous. It was the resurrection of Jesus from the dead. This was the sign that Jesus had done what only God can do and that is, break the power of sin and death. It is from this event that all of our beliefs about Jesus flow: that he is "God from God, light from light.....begotten not made, consubstantial with the father." All of these phrases which we profess most of the time in Sundays' liturgy are different ways of affirming that the Resurrection has revealed Jesus as the Lord of life and death.

The Resurrection event tells us something about Jesus, however, it also tells us something about the God whom we experience and encounter in the person of Jesus. The God we know in Jesus Christ is a God who is love, and that love is more incredible than our sin, a love that is awesome because it can triumph over sin and death. That is the Good news of Easter and we are called to spread and share to others. No matter how busy we are with the awesome and great celebration of Easter, it is appropriate to reflect and ask ourselves: what signs do I see in the secular world and in my life that Jesus has triumphed over death? How can I be an effective sign of God's love to others?

As we gather together as one family at our Easter meal, let us not forget to thank God for raising Jesus from the dead revealing the triumphant presence of love in the midst of anger, hatred and death. Let us pray to God that He would give us the grace to share the good news of Jesus' Resurrection with all those we encounter. Amen.

Important Parish Information

Parish Registration ... To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email frontoffice@sienachurch.org.

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

Young adults ...who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, **should register with the Parish under their own name.**

Weddings ... Please call the Parish Office **one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).**

Baptisms ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

Sponsorship ... In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... **also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months.** One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
