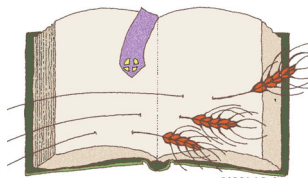

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Not by bread alone does one live,
but by every word that comes forth
from the mouth of the LORD.

— Deuteronomy 8:3b

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Every time we take part in the Eucharistic celebration, we should enter a more intimate relationship with Jesus Christ. "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him." Through that continuous encounter with our Lord, such persons will have real life, life everlasting.

Let me share with you a true story that happened some years ago. In 1263, a German priest named Peter of Prague was so troubled with doubts about the Real presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. He decided to make a pilgrimage to Rome and pray for guidance and direction in his troubles along the way. On his trip to Rome, he came to a small town in Central Italy called Bolsena. While celebrating Mass there, something amazing happened. As the priest held a host and said the words of consecration, blood started to seep out of the host onto his hands and then onto the linen cloth on the altar that we call the corporal. He soon asked to be taken to the nearby city of Orvieto where he knew that Pope Urban IV was then staying. The pope had the incident investigated and no natural explanation could be found for it. Pope Urban had the blood-stained host and corporal put on a display in the cathedral in Orvieto. The corporal is still there today to be revered by the faithful.

This Eucharistic miracle led Pope Urban to establish the solemnity we celebrate today. The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, which is also known by its Latin name, Corpus Christi. It was celebrated for the first time the following year in 1264.

As great a gift as the feast may continue for us as Catholics 750 years after the wondrous Eucharistic miracle at Bolsena, it is altogether simply a reminder to us that Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament journeys at our side as we make our pilgrimage through this world to our heavenly homeland.

Important Parish Information

Parish Registration ... To be recognized as a practicing member of the Parish, it is necessary to be registered, and to show your presence and support by attendance at Mass and through the regular use of offertory envelopes.

If you have questions regarding Parish Registration, please call 732-938-5375 or email frontoffice@sienachurch.org.

If you move or change addresses or parishes, please notify the Parish Office in a timely manner.

Young adults ...who are still living at home with their parents, who have graduated from college, and/or who are employed full-time, **should register with the Parish under their own name.**

Weddings ... Please call the Parish Office **one year in advance of desired wedding date, BEFORE completing any other arrangements (reception hall, etc.).**

Baptisms ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance.

Prior to the birth of the child, attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents, and sponsors/godparents also are encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. For more information, contact the parish office.

Sponsorship ... In order to be a sponsor/godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... **also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months.** One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
