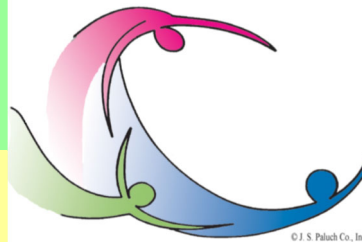

Dear Parishioners,

Our parish community is happy to welcome Deborah Scuotto as she publicly acknowledges her strong intention to become a catechumen and finally a Catholic. Hence, at the beginning of the 10 AM Mass this Sunday, we are going to have the Rite of Acceptance in the Narthex to manifest our excitement as a Church to accept her as a person who intends to become its member. May God shower his grace on Deborah as we pray for her faith journey.

The Knights of Columbus of our parish are going to have an orientation for their new members following the 10 and 11:30 Masses in the parish hall this Sunday. Let us show our support as we pray for their new leaders and members.

Today as we know is the 13th Sunday in Ordinary time. Ordinary Time in the Church's calendar is the time of the year that is not included in the Advent/Christmas cycle or Lent/Easter season. In other words, we will be in Ordinary Time now until the last weekend of November when the season of Advent begins. If you notice, the liturgical color for this season, Ordinary Time is green, the symbol of hope.

Hope is a positive attitude that carries all of us through life. Experience tells us that we either live a life of hope or we live lives that are hopeless and therefore we live lives of despair. Our readings today remind us of what our hope is built upon. No matter how marvelous the discoveries of science and medicine and technology are, none of us are going to live in this world forever. Why? Because according to God's plan and desire, none of us were created to live forever on this planet. He has created us to live with Him in eternity which is totally different from this present life that we have.

Sacred Scriptures teach us time and time again, and we heard it in today's first reading, that we make our own unhappiness by refusing to trust, to have faith in what God has spoken to us. Magnificently, God has spoken to us through his Son, Jesus Christ. Jesus has pointed out to us that He is the WAY, the TRUTH and the LIFE.

There are powerful and incredible words of Jesus in the Gospel today, "do not be afraid, just have faith." Keep in mind that these words came immediately after Jairus is informed that his daughter has died. The Gospel is about events that touch all of our lives at one time or another, events, occasions that scare us all: terminal illness for which there is no cure/remedy and death, most particularly the death of a young individual. Jesus is telling us "do not be afraid, just have faith."

For St. Paul, as we often hear from his letters, and for us faithful Catholics, death is only a falling asleep. Jesus is with us as we gather in prayer today, as we listen to him and his word is being proclaimed, as we receive his body and blood. Can we reach out to touch him and be open to whatever grace he might give us; can we listen to him and hear him say, "do not be afraid, just have faith"? Amen.

**Baptisms** ... The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 2nd and 4th Sundays at 12:30 P.M. or can be celebrated during Sunday Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance. Prior to scheduling the baptism of your child, sponsor letters, donation, and attendance at a Baptism Preparation Class is mandatory for parents. Sponsors/godparents are also encouraged to attend. Classes are held in the Church at 7:30 P.M. on the third Wednesday of each month. **Sponsorship** ... In order to be a sponsor/ godparent for Baptism or Confirmation, a person must have received all Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully ... **also, be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months.** One month's notice is desirable when requesting a Sponsor Certificate, a Letter of Recommendation for Parochial School, and other items of this nature.
