

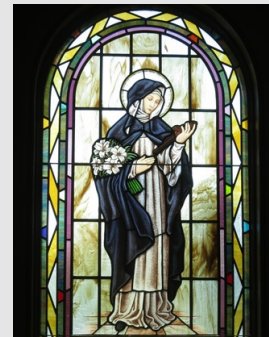

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend the Altar Rosary Society is offering a bake sale. Your invaluable support is highly appreciated. We thank the Society for their commitment and dedication. Let us welcome with gladness and excitement our Fifth and Sixth Graders at the 11:30 AM Mass today. Together, with their respective parents and teachers, let us celebrate the Liturgy with our active participation as we sing and pray wholeheartedly.

Today is the FIFTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR.

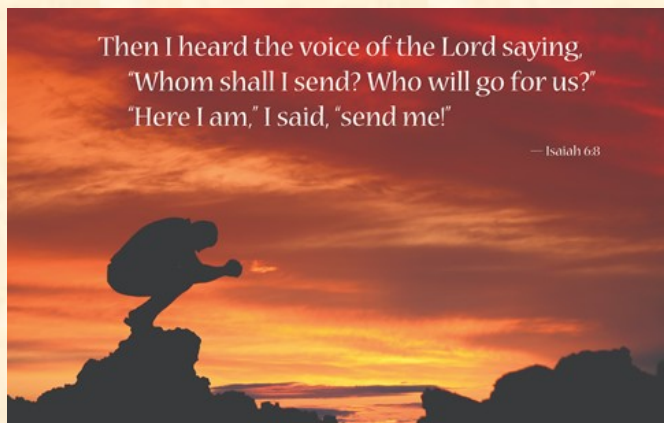
What is common to today's readings? The commonality is an admission that we are sinful, unworthy, unclean people. Isaiah calls himself "a man of unclean lips". Whereas, Peter says, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." How about Paul? Paul identifies himself as "the least of the apostles, not fit to be called an apostle." What is also noticeable to our readings is the power of God's mercy. Touching Isaiah's mouth the angel says, "Your wickedness is removed, your sin is purged." Isaiah is freed to proclaim God's presence, responding to God's call. So then, Jesus tells Simon, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching people." Paul proclaims, "By the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace to me has not been ineffective."

It is easy for us to be disheartened by our failings, our sins, our apparent inability to live up to our baptismal calling. However, it is tragic when we allow that to happen. As today's readings show, God is not put off because of our inadequacies and weaknesses. In fact, in God's eyes, no one is beyond God's mercy, no matter how often or how badly they may have failed. Nothing can shake God's love for us and often it is when we become conscious of our sinfulness that the Lord is ready to draw us closer to Him. This is not, of course, the way the world sees things but it is the logic of divine love. Moreover, once we are convinced that our God is a God whose name is mercy, then our failings, far from casting us down, will have the opposite effect.

As people of faith, we respond to the invitation to the Holy Communion, "Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof." We proclaim and admit our sinfulness. "Only say the word, and my soul shall be healed." We proclaim our trust in God's mercy and forgiveness. Amen.

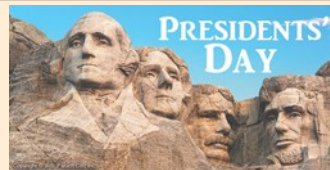

Please include your full name(s), address, and envelope number. Please do not wait until the last minute since email requests are done once a week in February.

On-line Giving: If you contribute online, the statement is provided by WeShare, not St. Catherine of Siena Parish. Statements will be mailed by the end of January (provided they have your correct email address). If you do not receive your email by early February, please contact the Parish Office at frontoffice@sienachurch.org.

Note: Online giving users can print your Giving History for 2018, but it is not an official tax document.

SACRAMENT & FAITH FORMATION

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: To schedule an anointing, call the Pastor's Office at 732-938-5375 OPT. 7.

BAPTISM: We celebrate Baptism on the second Sunday of each month at 12:30 PM or during the 11:30 AM Mass. Prior to scheduling the baptism of your child, sponsor letters, donation, and attendance at a **Baptism Preparation Class** is mandatory for parents. Classes are held in Classroom 10 on the **4th Sunday of the month**. To sign up, please fill out the registration form on our website for the date you wish to attend. Godparents/sponsors are also encouraged to attend. For more information, please call the Parish Office.

HOMEBOUND: If a homebound family member, friend, or neighbor would like to receive Holy Communion, visits, or calls, please contact the Parish Office.

MATRIMONY: Couples planning a marriage must contact the Parish Office to begin marriage preparation at least one year before the anticipated wedding date.

RCIA: The process by which adults become Catholic and/or receive the Sacraments is called Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. RCIA meets the 1st & 3rd Tuesday of each month at 7 PM.

SACRAMENTS FOR CHILDREN: The RCIA for children is a process that invites any child age 7 to 18, interested in the Catholic Faith, to discover what the Catholic Church teaches and believes. It is open to anyone seeking to get to know Jesus. Like the RCIA for adults, this process is accomplished in a comfortable, friendly and informal environment designed for children. Certain Rites are celebrated in the church throughout their journey in faith. Near the end of the process, the Sacraments of Initiation—Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist—are celebrated at the Easter Vigil. The RCIA for Children will be offered on the **1st, 2nd and 3rd Sunday of the Month October thru May**. Please contact the Parish Office for more information.

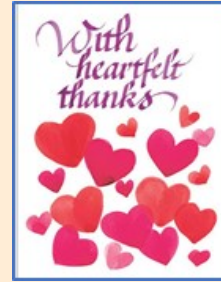
OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE OF ELIGIBILITY: In order to be a godparent/sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation, according to Canon Law, a person must have received all their Sacraments through Confirmation; be at least 16 years of age; if married, be married in the Catholic Church; attend Mass faithfully (*showing attendance through the use of your Church Envelopes, the Welcome Envelopes located in the narthex, or via WeShare Online Giving*); be a registered, actively participating parishioner for a minimum of six (6) months. Please stop by the Parish Office to fill out a form to be recommended for sponsorship. All requests will be seen by the Pastor and you will be notified when your form is ready.

OBTAIN A MASS CARD: We welcome all who would like to request their special intentions or deceased loved ones be prayed for at weekday or weekend Mass. Please call or stop by the Parish Office.

Prayer List: Please call the Parish Office to request a name be added to our prayer list.

MIRACULOUS MEDAL NOVENA: We welcome all on Monday's after the 9 am Mass in our Chapel.

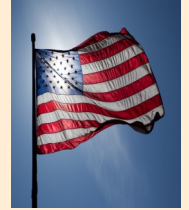
