



A Message from our Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

THIRTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

True worship is a heart aflame with love for God and for one's fellow human beings. If these two statements were taken seriously, it would not only save us a lot of trouble but inject much good sense, even good cheer, into the religious-minded. Instead of turning men and women into religious fanatics, it would make them healthy, balanced, whole, loving and lovable persons.

When religion, not relationships, is stressed, macabre rituals and magical mumbo-jumbo replace genuine worship. In the process, neither is God worshipped and honored, nor is man in any way bettered. Rather, both are insulted, even desecrated. Religion, devoid of right relationships between God and man, men among themselves and with the whole idea of creation becomes defiled, rotten.

Hence St. James enlighten us, "Religion that is pure and undefiled before God and the Father is this: to visit the orphans and the widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world" (1:27). St. John hits the nail on the head when he states: "If anyone says, 'I love God,' and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he does not love his brother, whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen. And this commandment scriptures speak of relationships based on love.

This the whole law, summed up in a nutshell; love of God and love of neighbor as oneself. This is pure religion, and the core of pure religion is rooted in love. Without this love-core relationship, religion is an empty shell. Moreover, it is pernicious and poisonous.

Hence there is worse and dangerous religion around that good religion, precisely because right relationship rooted in love is a rare commodity.

Christ made religion a matter of total relationship: the total person, mind, heart and strength consecrated to God in love and God totally giving Himself to humans in love. Religion is God and man pledging in unison, "I am totally yours."

As announced, we are celebrating the Solemnity of All Saints on Wednesday, November 1. Our Masses are both in Church, 9 A.M. and 7 P.M. We remember all the Saints and celebrate not only every saint recognized by the Church, but also their associates and followers, and indeed whose lives displayed demonstrable sanctity. It is also a time to remember all those who have been nominated as suitable for canonization, but cases remain under consideration. Furthermore, it reminds us of those enroute to full sainthood, who have reached the stage of veneration or beatification, but who have not yet been canonized, or have not been assigned a feast day.

About the year 731, Pope Gregory III consecrated a chapel in St. Peter's Church in honor of all the saints, and since then the feast of All Saints has been established in Rome. Keep in mind that the feast of All Saints is a holy day of obligation.

The reason for the Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed is the doctrine and belief that all who die in venial sin, or have not fully atoned for other past transgressions, are detained in purgatory, and that the faithful on earth can help them through their temporal punishment and hasten their admission to the joys of heaven by prayers and alms, and especially the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.





SPONSORSHIP FOR THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM AND CONFIRMATION

The godparents, together with the parents, must be willing to help the baptized grow in love for Christ and neighbor. By word and example, the godparents will encourage the candidate to live the Christian life and fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it (cf. Code of Canon Law, c. 872-874).

Requirements to Obtain a Sponsor Certificate/Letters of Eligibility

In St. Catherine's Parish and in all Catholic Parishes in the U.S.

- A sponsor must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist, & Confirmation and if married, married in the Catholic Church.
- A sponsor must be at least 16 years of age.
- A sponsor attends Mass faithfully participating in the life and support of the Church, receiving the Eucharist, and leading a life according to the teachings of the Church.

For sponsor requests from St. Catherine's, you must be registered at

St. Catherine of Siena Parish and registered for at least six (6) months prior to the request, showing participation in the life & support of the Church.

Note, if he/she received all his/her sacraments here at St. Catherine of Siena Parish years ago <u>but</u> now lives elsewhere, he/she is not a member of <u>this parish</u>.

Rather, he/she is a member of the parish in whose territory he/she resides. This is where the sponsor certificate must be obtained.

Baptism

First-time parents are required to attend a Baptismal Preparation Class prior to scheduling the Baptism.

Godparents are required to provide Sponsor Certificates before a Baptismal date is given.

Engaged Couples should contact our parish at least one year in advance of the proposed date of marriage and before making other arrangements.


Low Gluten Host


